8	Screws (X4)	Fix an HDD to the HDD drawer.

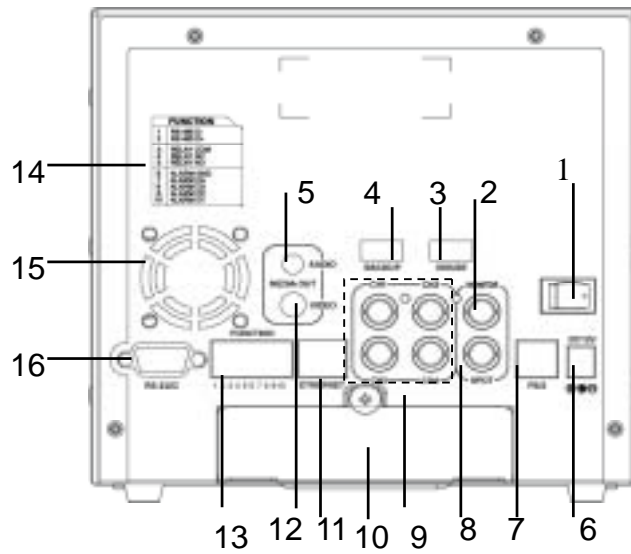

Items	Function
1. 8" LCD Display	Displays images.
2. Speakers	Gives sounds.
3. Receiver (IR Port)	Receives IR signals out of the remote controller.
4. Power LED	Gives red light when the power is on.
5. Control Buttons	Control the OSD menu of the LCD.

<input type="checkbox"/> <i>SOURCE</i>	Video Source Switch (DVR / MEDIA)
<input type="checkbox"/> <i>MENU</i>	Open OSD menu for LCD adjustment.
<input type="checkbox"/> <i>UP</i>	Move up. / Increase values or volume.
<input type="checkbox"/> <i>DOWN</i>	Move down. / Decrease values or volume.

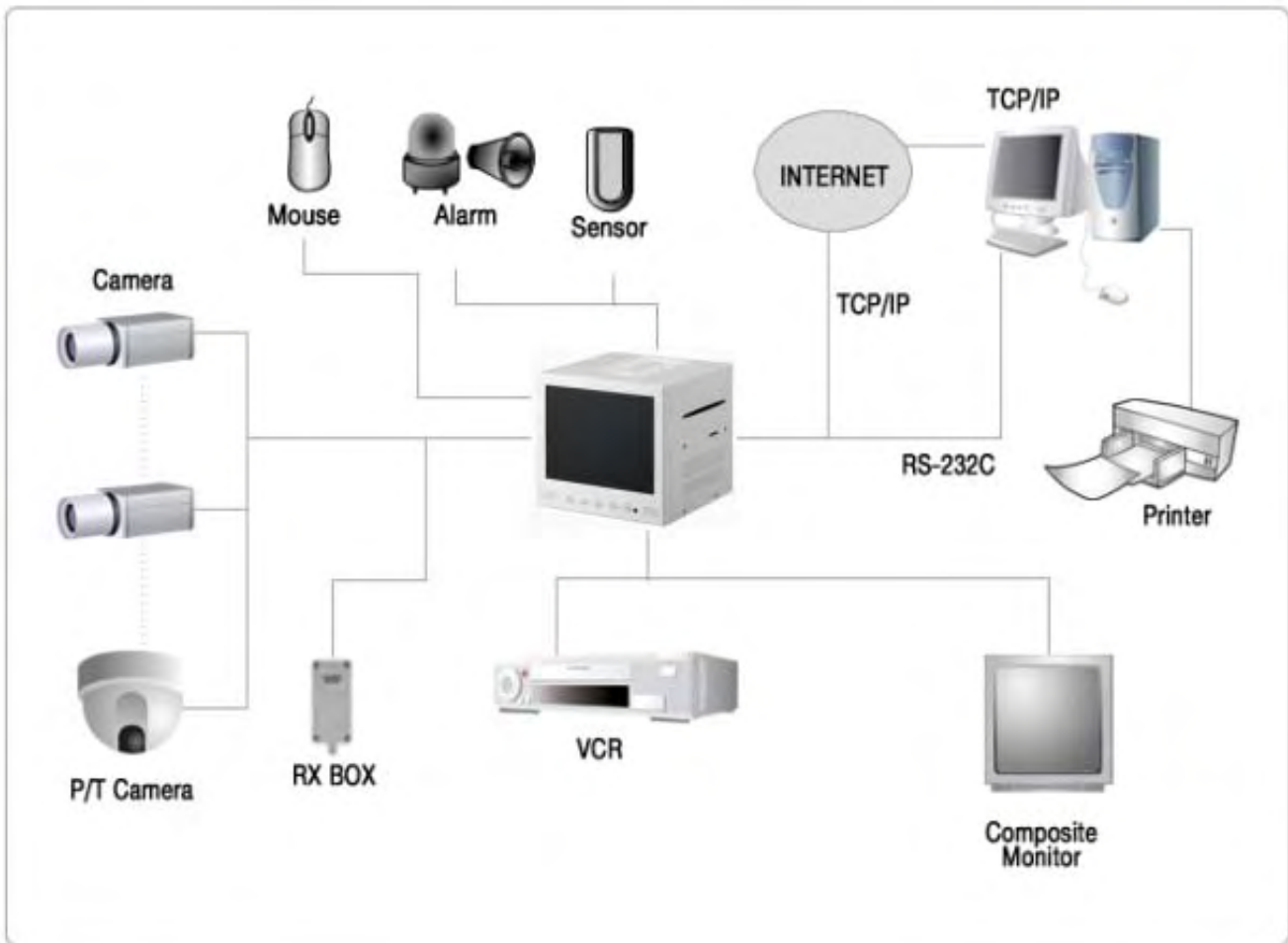

1	Power Switch	Media DVR Power Switch (On/Off)	
2	MONITOR	Connects a monitor (NTSC / PAL).	
3	MOUSE	Connects a USB mouse.	
4	BACKUP	(1) For Backup of DVR Video Images (2) For DVR Firmware Upgrade	
5	MEDIA AUDIO OUT	Connects a monitor for the Media Player. (for LR-804J02 only.)	
6	DC 12 V	Connects a DC 12 V / 5A power supply. (for LR-804J02 only.)	
7	PS/2	Connects a PS/2 mouse.	
8	SPOT	Connects a SPOT monitor.	
9	CH 1~4	Connect cameras.	
10	HDD Drawer	For HDD Combination ((1) The jumper must be master. (2)The HDD is expandable to 500 GB.)	
11	ETHERNET	Connects the Ethernet.	
12	MEDIA VIDEO OUT	Connects a monitor for the Media Player.	
13	FUNCTION	Function Port for External Devices	
14	Function Port Note	1~2	For External Devices (eg. Speed Domes)

15	Fan	Moderates the Media DVR's temperature.

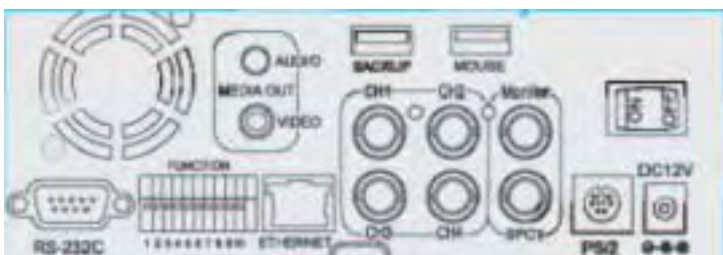
3-1. Installation Configuration



3-2. Camera Connection

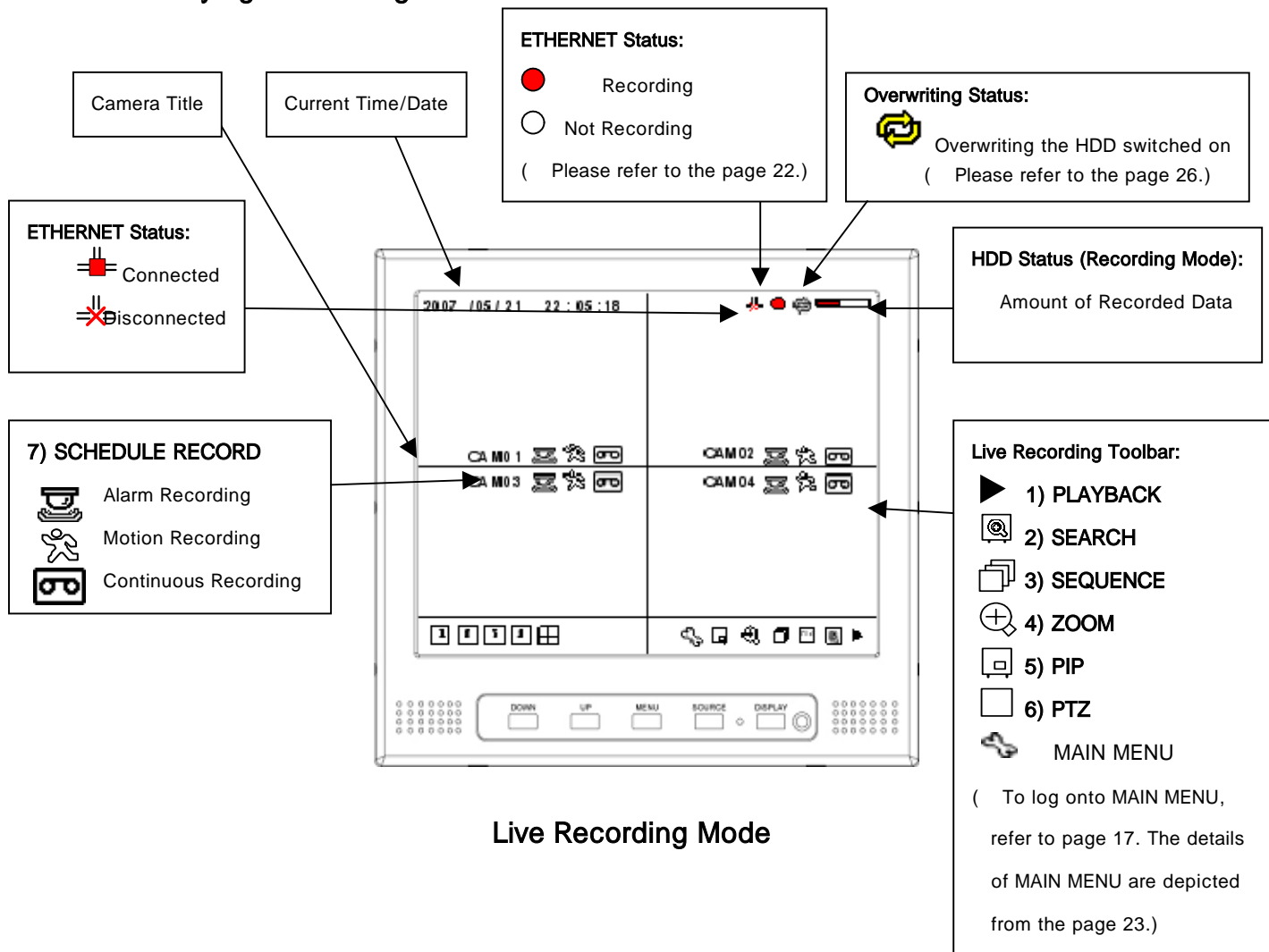
Procedure:

- Turn on DVR power and adjust camera lens viewing angle.



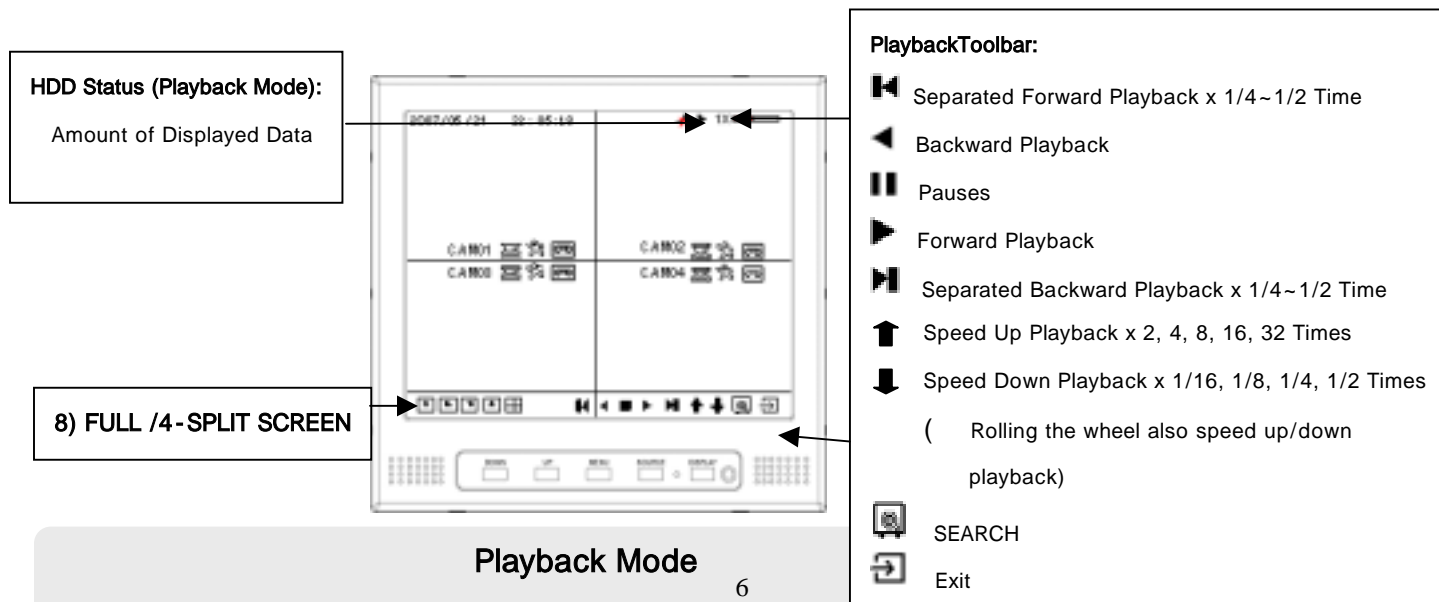

4-2. Live Playing/ Recording Mode PLAYBACK















Function Overview of Buttons

BUTTON	DESCRIPITON	
	Power	Power on/off the Media Player.
	Setup	Display the setup menu.
	Menu	Display the root menu of the disc.
	Eject	Eject/Draw in the disc.
	Audio	Select the audio language.
	Subtitle	Select the subtitle language or turn it on/off.
	Repeat	Select the repeat type for media playing.
	Display	Display information about the disc.
	Slow	Play at 1/2, 1/3, 1/4, 1/5, 1/6 or 1/7 time normal speed.
	0-9, 10+	Input numbers.
	Rewind	Scan backward at 2, 4, 8 or 16 times normal speed.
	Fast Forward	Scan forward at 2, 4, 8, or 16 times normal speed.
	Play	Play media files
	Pause	(Once) Go into the pause mode. (2 or more times) Go into the setup mode.
	Previous	Go back to the preceding track or scene during playback.
	Next	Go to the next chapter, track or scene during playback.
	Stop	(Once) Pause at the present playing point. (2 or more times) Stop playing.
	Up	Move up (for navigating the setup menu).
	Down	Move down (for navigating the setup menu).
	Left	Move left (for navigating the setup menu).
	Right	Move right (for navigating the setup menu).
	Enter	Execute the selected item or setting.
